Canine Inspection

Rose utilizes canine detection with NESDCA* Certified dogs to identify infested units in the most efficient manner possible. The canine, handler along with Rose personnel



will visit the units, and provide the owner with a clear picture of bed bug activity.

Advantages:

- Canines are proven to be one of the most cost effective alternatives to full-structure treatment.
- They are able to identify and detect all stages of bed bugs (from egg to adult) in their hiding places.

Please note: Canines will not be used to detect bed bugs if a room has been chemically treated with insecticides in the last 30 days.

*National Entomology Scent Detection Canine Association (NESDCA) has established working standards for all entomology scent detecting canines, handlers and trainers through an accreditation program.

HEAT IS LETHAL TO BED BUGS

While bed bugs show a surprising tolerance for cold temperatures they readily succumb to heat. Temperatures as low as 113°F can be lethal to bed bugs after an hour or more. Higher temperatures can eliminate bed bugs in minutes or even seconds.

ELIMINATE BED BUGS IN ONE DAY

Many of the bed bug eradication treatments available today require multiple visits with extensive preparation.

Heat, applied correctly, can eliminate a bed bug infestation within a day treated rooms can be occupied that same day.

ECONOMIC AND FLEXIBLE

Aside from being a green-process, heat is one of the most cost and time effective methods for eliminating bed bug infestations.

- Heat effectively penetrates furniture and matresses where bed bugs often hide; allowing you to salvage your personal belongings and avoid throwing items away unnecessarily.
- Heat allows you to treat the entire structure or spot-treat the high infestation areas while other sections of the structure remain operational.
- Preparation is less extensive for the owner or occupant than required for other treatments.

THE HEAT TREATMENT PROCESS

Inspections - Before and Following Treatment

- ✓ Our technicians perform thorough inspections before and after the treatment. Familiar with the habits and biology of the bed bug, they are experienced in locating even the smallest infestation.
- ✓ Thorough inspections are a critical part of the elimination process and are completed in the infested room and the hallways or rooms adjoining the infested room.



Preparation Checklist

- ✓ You will be provided with a heat treatment preparation checklist prior to your scheduled visit.
- ✓ The checklist will provide you with a list of steps to take to avoid damaging property and potentially dangerous situations. Most items however, can remain in the structure during the heat treatment without being harmed.



Day of Treatment

- ✓ Portable electric heaters and fans are brought in and placed throughout the infested room. We use a diesel generator to operate the portable heaters from inside our trailer for quieter operation.
- ✓ The temperature is raised to a level lethal to bed bugs and held for a pre-determined period of time. The treatment time will vary based on factors such as clutter, the layout of the structure and spaces within, severity of the infestation and airflow management.
- ✓ Our technicians use portable electronic sensors to ensure the temperature remains at the effective level throughout the entire process. They will move and rotate the contents of the room to make sure cold spots are eliminated.



Education

Experts agree that the number one reason for the rapid spread of bed bugs in the US is simply a lack of education and information. Poverty and poor hygiene are not the cause. It is understanding how the bed bug travels, where to inspect for signs of an infestation and what to do if signs are found.
