Arriving At Your Hotel Room

- Bags on the floor (not on the bed)
- Check the headboard
- Pull up sheets
- Check mattress & box springs
- Look under box springs
- Check night stand



Bed bugs are most likely to be:

- around the head boards
- in bed frames

Bed bugs may be:

- Behind pictures
- In furniture
- In other hidden places



- Check the headboards
- They usually just hang on a bracket on the wall.
- If you have no help lift up and check one side, then the other









- Pull up sheets
- Check mattress
 around piping





- Pull up the dust ruffle
- Check box springs
 - Corner protectors
 - Underneath
- Check bed frame





- Check night stand
- Pull out drawers
 - Check insides
 - Check undersides







If you find bed bugs

- Call the manager immediately
- Insist on another room
